Fabric: 100% polyamide Palm material: Goat leather

Insulation:100gr. fibrefill + 10 mm foamon backhand.

Knit cuff: 100% acrylic

The size of the gloves are marked on a label at the hand back. Following sizes are available: 8, 9, 10, 11 (sizes are defined in accordance with EN 420:1994)

CLEANING/MAINTENANCE/STORAGE - Preferably clean the gloves using a brush. Washing in water or dry cleaning can change the characteristics of the material, in which case the manufacturer do not accept any liability.
